Hotel Thingholt

The stylish and central Thingholt takes elements of the Icelandic landscape and cleverly works them into the hotel's design. The look is sleek and modern, combining black, white and chrome with cowskin rugs, salmon-skin wall tiles and leather flooring.

The modern, sleek Hotel Thingholt is located in the heart of Reykjavik's action - just off the main shopping and socialising street of Laugavegur. Yet inside it feels calm and serene, with a huge open-plan lobby/bar, plenty of clean concrete lines and pared-down colours of grey, white and black.

The design combines a heavy industrial style with influences from Icelandic landscape and nature - salmon-skin tiles cover the lobby walls, while a "lava" wall and waterfall makes a feature of the entrance.



Hotel Thingholt, rooms

Rooms are uncompromisingly contemporary, dominated by a monochrome colour scheme, white leather upholstery, stylised bathrooms and wooden details to soften the look. Practical touches include free internet and in-room tea/coffee.

On the ground floor there's a spacious lobby bar combining leather sofas and indoor foliage, alongside a cosy breakfast room where guests tuck into a buffet breakfast of eggs, cereal, pastries and fruit around communal tables.
